



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



How do I register?

Registrations are done through Dribl, via the direct website; <https://registration.dribl.com/club/287> or via our Minchinbury Jet SC website - <https://www.minchinburyjets.com>

Do you have registration days?

We will have our Club Registration Days held at the Minchinbury Reserve on the following dates:

Saturday 10th February
Saturday 17th February
Saturday 24th February

All days from 9am to 2pm

What age groups are there?

We cater for all age groups from Under 5's all the way up to Over 35's. We offer mixed, male and female teams. The age group will be based on the age that you turn in 2024.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



When will the season begin?

The season will start at the end of March and finish mid-August for all Under 5 to Under 11 teams as well as competition teams who do not qualify for finals. The teams who qualify for the finals will play an additional 1 to 3 weeks depending on how they progress.

Do you accept Active Kids Vouchers?

Yes, we do, we are an approved active kids' provider. Please ensure you claim your voucher before you start the registration process as it needs to be applied when you register before the payment process. Please visit our club website as we have a direct link to the Service NSW website in order to claim your Active Kids Voucher.

What nights are training held?

Training nights differ per team based on the coach's decision. Once you are placed in a team, the coach will advise you of when training will be held. Training nights vary from Monday to Thursday usually.

Which team will my child be in?

The team your child plays in will be based if they have played last year and for which team and on their ability and skill level. The decision may be made after our grading day.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



What is grading?

Grading is the process used to determine the best fit for a child to ensure they are playing in the right division based on their abilities. This is subject to the number of players who register for each age group and the numbers of teams which we can form.

When is grading held?

If grading is required, then this will be done towards the end of February. Times and location will be advised prior. Players must be registered prior to grading.

What is Meet The Coach Day?

We will have our "Meet the Coach" day on in late February / early March at the Minchinbury Reserve. Date and times to be advised closer to the date. You will find out what team your child is in and have the opportunity for parents/guardians to volunteer their services to be the team Coach or Manager.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Do you do background checks on coaches?

All members of the club who deal with kids under the age of 18 must have a valid Working With Children check/number. This includes the committee, coaches and managers for all teams.

Will I need to buy my club kit?

Playing jerseys will be provided by the club and you will need to return these at the end of the season.

All Junior and Youth players will be issued with a soccer ball which is to be used for training throughout the season. This ball will be theirs to keep at the end of the season.

Shorts and socks can be purchased from Uniform Shop at the Club or via our online Uniform store on our website.

Club shorts and socks **MUST** be worn on game days.

Players must also have their own football boots and shin pads for all training sessions and game days.

Are games played during the school holidays?

Yes they are, the only two weekends with no games are the Easter long weekend and June long weekend. The June long weekend may be used for catch up games if any weekends prior to that are rained out.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Are all the games played at the same location?

Games are played against other clubs within the Blacktown LGA, so approximately half the games will be at our home ground and the other half will be away across other fields within the Blacktown region.

How will we know where games are played each week?

Prior to the season starting, a draw will be published by the BDSFA which shows all your games, start times and location for the year. These do change sometimes however your team manager / coach will advise you each week.
